I have performed my self in Virtual Orchestration whith M° Antonio Genovino and M° Maurizio Gabrieli and I have attended masterclasses on music new tecnologies (by IRCAM Paris and Tristan Murail).

I am the author of the book "Una Vera Orchestra Virtuale", the first book in Italy about virtual orchestration.

I wrote music for exhibitions, multimedia DVD, performances, documentaries and several TV spots (by Rai, Radio Rai and digital terrestrial TV broadcasting).

In 2008 I found - and actually I manage - MultiMediaVda, web agency in Aosta (we provide Web Design, SEO and SEM services).

I got Sibelius and Steinberg Teacher certification, I'm professor of "Computer Music" course at the Musical Institute of Valle d'Aosta, of guitar at the musical middle school, and "New Technologies" at the Musical High School of Aosta.
